<p>Emerald</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All times tables to 12x12 on a multiplication grid. • Division facts on the reverse. • Timed: 10 minutes • All correct answers within the time limit. • Prize: Certificate presented in class.
<p>Sapphire</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10 times tables on a multiplication grid. • Division facts on the reverse. • Timed: 10 minutes • All correct answers within the time limit. • Prize: Certificate presented in class.
<p>Citrine</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2,3,4,5,8,10 times tables on a multiplication grid. • Division facts on the reverse. • Timed: 10 minutes • All correct answers within the time limit. • Prize: Certificate presented in class.
<p>Amethyst</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2,3,5,10 times tables in written form. • Division facts on the reverse. • Timed: 10 Minutes • All correct answers within the time limit. • Prize: Certificate presented in class.
<p>Amber</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2,5 and 10 times tables in written form. • Times tables can be taken individually but competency needs to be shown in all three to receive the award. • Tests are not timed but teacher discretion to decide if children are competent to receive the award. • Prize: Certificate presented in class.
<p>Onyx</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s to the 10th number in the sequence. • Each one to be taken at a separate time, but competency in all three is required to complete the award. • Prize: Certificate presented in class.
