Year	Skills to have achieved by the end of each year.
1	All children should be able to log onto the PC.
	 They should also develop the following text-based skills using Microsoft Word: To type with both hands To use the space and enter buttons correctly To select and edit text using the backspace and arrow keys. To format text by making it bold, italic or underline To save their work in a folder
2	All children should be confidently and independently logging onto the PC.
	 They should also consolidate previous text-based skills as well as develop the following using Microsoft Word: To save and retrieve work from the (s)drive confidently To use the shift button correctly To cut, copy and paste text To use the undo and redo keys To insert a picture into their text
3	Children should be able to log onto the Chromebooks using their personal email addresses and passwords.
	 They should be reminded of previous text-based skills and apply them to Google Docs as well as developing the following: To save and retrieve work from the Google Drive. To insert and format pictures including resizing and repositioning To 'screen shot' images and paste into another document (link to e-safety – being able to save evidence of cyber bullying) To use <ctrl> keyboard shortcuts.</ctrl>
	To use bullet points and numbering effectively.
4	 Children should be logging onto the Chromebooks independently. They will apply their knowledge of text-based skills whilst developing the following skills using Google Slides: To insert slides, add and type in a text box To insert images To format text and text boxes To use slide transitions
5	Children should be confidently logging onto the Chromebooks independently.
	 They will consolidate and build upon their previous skills on Google Slides: To insert audio and video files (where applicable) To set when the audio or video file plays To use animations to introduce text/picture on a slide To evaluate and reorder slides and present their presentation

6	Children will be expected to use a range of the above skills to demonstrate their creativity across the curriculum on the Chromebooks.
	They will begin to create spreadsheets using Google Sheets focussing on the following skills:
	 To insert text and numbers into a spreadsheet
	 To identify and refer to cells by row and column
	 To enter functions such as SUM, AVERAGE, MIN and MAX
	To create a graph using data
	 To design a spreadsheet for a specific purpose
