

# Text-based Skills Development

## Year 1 to Year 6

Year	Skills to have achieved by the end of each year.
1	<p>All children should be able to log onto the PC.</p> <p>They should also develop the following text-based skills using <b>Microsoft Word</b>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To type with both hands</li><li>• To use the space and enter buttons correctly</li><li>• To select and edit text using the backspace and arrow keys.</li><li>• To format text by making it bold, italic or underline</li><li>• To save their work in a folder</li></ul>
2	<p>All children should be confidently and independently logging onto the PC.</p> <p>They should also consolidate previous text-based skills as well as develop the following using <b>Microsoft Word</b>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To save and retrieve work from the (s)drive confidently</li><li>• To use the shift button correctly</li><li>• To cut, copy and paste text</li><li>• To use the undo and redo keys</li><li>• To insert a picture into their text</li></ul>
3	<p>Children should be able to log onto the Chromebooks using their personal email addresses and passwords.</p> <p>They should be reminded of previous text-based skills and apply them to <b>Google Docs</b> as well as developing the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To save and retrieve work from the Google Drive.</li><li>• To insert and format pictures including resizing and repositioning</li><li>• To 'screen shot' images and paste into another document (<b>link to e-safety – being able to save evidence of cyber bullying</b>)</li><li>• To use &lt;ctrl&gt; keyboard shortcuts.</li><li>• To use bullet points and numbering effectively.</li></ul>
4	<p>Children should be logging onto the Chromebooks independently.</p> <p>They will apply their knowledge of text-based skills whilst developing the following skills using <b>Google Slides</b>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To insert slides, add and type in a text box</li><li>• To insert images</li><li>• To format text and text boxes</li><li>• To use slide transitions</li></ul>
5	<p>Children should be confidently logging onto the Chromebooks independently.</p> <p>They will consolidate and build upon their previous skills on <b>Google Slides</b>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To insert audio and video files (where applicable)</li><li>• To set when the audio or video file plays</li><li>• To use animations to introduce text/picture on a slide</li><li>• To evaluate and reorder slides and present their presentation</li></ul>

6	<p>Children will be expected to use a range of the above skills to demonstrate their creativity across the curriculum on the Chromebooks.</p> <p>They will begin to create spreadsheets using <b>Google Sheets</b> focussing on the following skills:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To insert text and numbers into a spreadsheet</li> <li>• To identify and refer to cells by row and column</li> <li>• To enter functions such as SUM, AVERAGE, MIN and MAX</li> <li>• To create a graph using data</li> <li>• To design a spreadsheet for a specific purpose</li> </ul>
