Parents' Open Afternoon - Wednesday 13th November 2024

The next opportunity for you to meet with your child's teacher will be on the afternoon and evening of Wednesday 13th November.

Letters inviting you to book an appointment will be issued on Monday 4th November. Please return these as quickly as possible so we can accommodate the times that suit you.

If you require more than one appointment (i.e. for parents who do not attend together) please make us aware of this. Consultations will be for ten minutes and it is most important that we stick rigidly to the times specified – failure to do so can mean that appointments are missed.

If the ten-minute slot does not give you sufficient time to discuss all that you need to with your child's teacher, please arrange another appointment at a mutually convenient time.

Half Term Safety

Children have been reminded in assembly of the importance of staying safe at Halloween and Bonfire Night celebrations. I have been asked by Merseyside Police to remind you of the many events taking place on Monday 4^{th} November to prevent anti-social behaviour that they fear may take place on 'Mischief Night' this year.

Applying for a Place at High School

The window for applying for a High School place in September 2025 is now open. If you have a child in Year Six, you must follow the instructions on the letter posted on our website today or visit

www.sefton.gov.uk/startingschool

Parents/carers of ALL Year Six aged children MUST apply for a mainstream high school place, this includes children in Classes 8, 9, 10 and 12 who are unlikely to attend a mainstream school. We appreciate that this may appear to be an unnecessary exercise but it remains the only way of your child being in the system to gain a place in a special school or similar.

The closing date for registering for a high school place is 31st October 2024.
