### FREE PLACES for benefit related Free school meal children

As part of the HAF program we have limited FREE places available on a first come first served basis. We will be providing a healthy hot meal and snack supplied by an outside caterer along with drinks throughout the day.

To receive a free place your child must meet the following criteria:

- be eligible for benefit related Free school meals and live in Sefton
- attend for a minimum 4 hours per funded day
- It will be on a first come first served basis
- Please state that you are eligible for the free place on the text. I have to then check this with school to confirm eligibility

### Paid places are also available - Our camps are £15 per day or £60 for the full week.

Camp 1: Multi Sports 7th April - 11th April at Linacre Primary School, Bootle, L20 5ED - enter via the main gate on Litherland Road. Drop off 9:00 - pick up at 3:00.

Camp 2: Multi Sports 7th April - 11th April at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Primary School, Grantham Road, Southport, PR8 4LT. Entrance is the blue gate to the left of the school. Drop off 9:00 - pick up at 3:00.

Camp 3: Multi Sports 14th April - 17th April at Linacre Primary School, Bootle, L20 5ED - enter via gate on Litherland Road. Drop off 9:00 - pick up at 3:00.

Camp 4: Multi Sports 14th April - 17th April at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Primary School, Grantham Road, Southport, PR8 4LT. Entrance is the blue gate to the left of the school. Drop off 9:00 - pick up at 3:00.
