Monitoring your child's social media activity

From time to time it is necessary for me to remind you of the importance of rigorously checking your child's activity on social media. We know that many children have mobile phones and other internet enabled devices such as iPads. As a means of helping you to keep your child safe (i.e. always being able to contact them) and of enjoying safe and age-appropriate games, sites and film footage etc. these devices are a most wonderful invention.

Sadly, we have had another week in school where the deeply troubling aspects of mobile phone/internet use has revealed how they can also be cause of deep distress and emotional harm.

Children are not allowed to use mobile phones in school so I am making reference to social media activity that takes place out of school. You may be wondering (very legitimately) why children's mobile phone/social media activity that takes place out of school is any concern of mine - I wish it wasn't!

This week, we have had to deal with several cases of children coming to school upset and certainly not in the best frame of mind for learning because of highly offensive comments made to them or about them on WhatsApp groups. It would appear that most of our classes (certainly in Year Four and above) have at least one WhatsApp group. In our experience, these can often start innocently but as other (often much older) children are added, comments can become deeply personal and insulting.

We have even had WhatsApp groups given names that refer to children in worryingly offensive terms and that contain prejudicial language.

I am very grateful to those of you who have discussed this sensitive issue with me and my colleagues. On several occasions, parents have shared screenshots with me of comments that children at The Grange are making to one another. In some cases, these contain foul and abusive language.

Please understand that the responsibility of monitoring your child's WhatsApp activity (and that on other platforms) is yours. Please also understand that when a child is reluctant to come to school or comes to school fearful and upset due to comments made to or about them, this does become something that we have to deal with.

The problem is not unique to The Grange - studies show that days of learning are lost each year in schools as teachers have to resolve conflict caused by social media, sometimes on a daily basis.

Children who we feel need to hear this message again (i.e. those who are at an age when they may own a phone and/or access social media) attended an assembly today reminding them of the e-safety message. We hope that we are doing all that we practically can in school, so ...

PLEASE MONITOR WHAT YOUR CHILD IS DOING ON HIS/HER PHONE OR TABLET AS OFTEN AS POSSIBLE - Thank you.

Video calling is as convenient as a phone call, with the added value of face-to-face communication.

It can save you time and money, and brings your care closer to home.



Where do I go to attend my appointment?

Instead of travelling to your appointment, you enter the clinic's online waiting area. The health service is notified when you arrive, and your clinician will join you when ready.

There is no need to create an account.

No information you enter is stored.

✓ What do I need to make a video call?

- ✓ A good connection to the internet
If you can watch a video online (e.g. YouTube) you can make a video call
- ✓ A private, well-lit area where you will not be disturbed during the consultation
- ✓ One of these:
 -  Google Chrome web browser on a desktop or laptop, or on an Android tablet or smartphone
 -  Safari web browser on an Apple iMac, MacBook, iPad, or iPhone
- ✓ Web-camera, speakers and microphone already built into laptops or mobile devices

Is it secure?

Video calls are secure; your privacy is protected.

You have your own private video room that only authorised clinicians can enter.

↓ How much internet data will I use?

You don't use any data while waiting for a clinician to join you.

A video call uses a similar amount of data to Skype® or FaceTime®.

£ How much does a video call cost?

The video call is free (except for your internet usage).

If you can, connect to a home or work Wi-Fi network to avoid using your mobile data allowance.

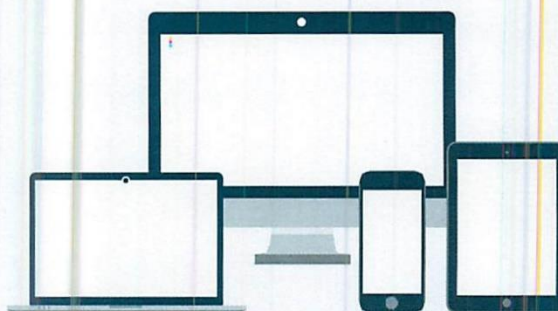

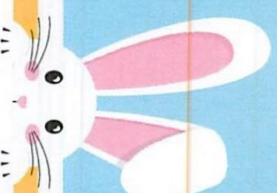
